- Provides emergency alerting capability from centralized locations to user in multiple means:
 - Work Phone/Email
 - Personal Phone/Email
 - Text Messaging
 - Emergency Contact
- System should be resident on all AF and Army computers, allowing users the ability to update their contact information
 - Left Click on "Show Hidden Icons"
 - Right Click on "JBER [powered by atHoc]"
 - Left Click on "Update My Device Info"

AtHoc Deployment - JBER What is AtHOC & How Can I Use?



- Mandatory fields for Active Duty, AGR, and Res (on Active Duty) will be: "Text message number", "Work – Phone", "Work – Email", "Gov't cell phone", "Personal E-Mail", "Personal cell phone" and "Emergency Contact"
 - Drill Status Guardsman are encouraged to register in the AtHoc system by updating their "Text message number", "Work - Phone", "Work – E-Mail", and "Government issued cell phone."
 - Government Civilian Personnel will register in the system by updating "My Info" and "Devices" fields with the following mandatory items: "Text message number", "Work - Phone", "Work – E-Mail," "Government issued cell phone".
 - Drill Status Guardsman and Gov't Civilians are highly encouraged to provide additional contact information, including an "Emergency Contact" of their choice (i.e. spouse)
- Business rules: JBER Instruction 10-2501
- Centralized message publishing from 673 ABW Command Post
 - Groups and squadrons may publish to their units only, as long as they have appointed AtHoc Non-Core Operators and/or End user managers.
