Enrollment Changes

- The TRICARE benefit will transition from a Fiscal Year period to a Calendar Year period
- If at the end of 2017, your DEERS record shows you as:
 - TRICARE Prime, you will automatically be enrolled in TRICARE Prime on January 1, 2018. You do NOT have to do anything.
 - TRICARE Standard, you will automatically be enrolled in TRICARE Select on January 1, 2018. You do NOT have to do anything.
 - Grace Period: Jan 1 – Dec 31, 2018.
 - You can change plans (Prime/Select) at any time; enrollment fees may apply
 - Starting January 1, 2019, you will only be able to enroll/change plans during two periods:
 - Open Enrollment Season (mid November – mid December)
 - Up to 90 days following a Qualifying Life Event.
 - QLE: Marriage, Divorce, Childbirth, Moving/PCS, Death, and Retirement
 - Pregnancy is NOT a QLE
 - During open enrollment season if you do nothing you will stay in the same plan.

- **#1: Slips and falls**
 - #1 overall in DoD
 - #1 in Alaska in winter
 - average, all populations
- **#2: Motor vehicle collisions**
 - #1 in ages 18-24
 - DoD and all Alaska
- **#3: Sports/recreational accidents**
 - Most injuries are preventable

Preventing TBI

- **Slips and falls**
 - Wear flat-soled footwear with traction
 - “yak tracks”
 - Prepare walkways and stairs
 - Adequate lighting
 - Free of clutter
 - Sprinkle ice melt on icy patches on driveways and sidewalks
 - Watch for icy patches, ice covered with snow
 - Take short steps
- **Motor vehicle safety**
 - Install studded or all-weather tires
 - Slow down, brake gradually
 - Leave extra room between your vehicle and others

Preventing TBI

- **Sports/recreational activities**
 - Wear a helmet (and make sure children wear helmets)
 - Snow machining (snowmobiling)
 - Alpine (downhill) skiing
 - Snowboarding
 - Sledding
 - Ice hockey
 - Follow all safety rules
 - Take a class
 - Know your limits (and your children's)

Operation Supplemental Safety (OPSS)



- FDA does NOT approve dietary supplements for safety and effectiveness
- Stick with brands that have undergone “third party certification” (e.g. USP)
- Avoid “Stacking”! Using multiple similar-acting supplements (including energy drinks) is especially hazardous
- Most common reasons for using supplements: build muscle, lose weight, increase energy





Common Myths

“I can safely drop 25 lbs in a week.”

“It’s sold at the Exchange, so it must be safe.”

FACT: FDA doesn’t validate safety of supplements

“If one dose (or drink) is good, then 2 or 3 are even better.”

“Proper nutrition and physical activity now comes in pill form.”

“If it’s on the label, it must be true.”

“Supplements won’t cause me to have a positive drug test.”

FACT: Supplements may be adulterated with prescription and illegal drugs!

Real ID Act

- Congressional Law passed in 2005:
 - Prohibits Federal agencies from accepting State issued DL's or ID's unless they meet minimum security requirements
 - Approximately 14,000 contractors and local service providers may be negatively impacted and required to have alternative forms of identification by 10 Oct 2018
 - The Real ID Act will not impact those with current Federal credentials for accessing the installation ie CAC/DoD cards
 - VISITORS who do not possess a REAL ID Act credential may be escorted by a DoD sponsor via the Trusted Traveler program

Uber/Lyft Operations

- Uber/Lyft Policy Overview (JBERI 31-113):
 - Currently Uber regional office has been provided a list of drivers for employment verification to be granted access
 - Lyft has not made contact with the Base Access Office
 - Taxi companies, including Uber and Lyft, are limited to 100 drivers bi-annually
 - Trusted Traveler cannot be used by DoD members to escort taxis, Uber, Lyft or any other transportation service provider
 - Members who currently possess a DoD credential may seek employment as an Uber or Lyft driver on the installation






