- 1. (Air Carrier Name) acknowledges that no representations or warranties are made regarding the condition of the facilities or gravel airfield located at (Airfield Name(s)), Alaska. They are made available pursuant to paragraph 1 of the Supplemental Conditions of Use and (Air Carrier Name) agrees to use of the property in an "as is" condition. (Air Carrier Name) agrees to have fire extinguishers, first aid kits, and a first aid qualified individual on site at all times during its aircraft operations. (Air Carrier Name) agrees that it assumes responsibility for maintaining any existing equipment located at the site in at least the same state as prior to arrival, and that it is responsible for all employees, aircrew members, and customers in connection with its air operations.

(Air Carrier Name) agrees to maintain and operate its aircraft in accordance with DOT operating, airworthiness, and safety directives and with all other applicable federal, state, and local regulations. (Air Carrier Name) further agrees to comply with all Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and DOT guidance regarding air traffic reporting, flight planning, and aircraft maintenance. (Air Carrier Name) agrees to have an Air Force approved DD Form 2400, Civil Aircraft Certificate of Insurance, DD Form 2401, Civil Aircraft Landing Permit with Supplemental Conditions of Use, and an expanded DD Form 2402, Hold Harmless Agreement, before operating at these locations.
