Cold Weather Injury Prevention

Dress for Conditions:

- Make sure your gloves, coats, hat, and boots are in good condition before going outside
- Dress in loose layers

Have a Plan:

- Plan how long you want to be outside and stick to your plan
 - Ensure someone knows when you will return
- Know the hazards of where you'll be going (frozen ponds, windy areas, etc.)

Enhance Skills:

- Take a winter survival course
- Know how to recognize and treat hypothermia and frostbite

Hone Safety Skills:

- Ski with someone Buddy system
- Stay on the trails <u>DO NOT</u> go out of bounds
- Get/stay in shape, stretch out
- Knock the rust off take a lesson
- Know weather conditions
- Yield right of way
- Stop on the sides not in the middle of slope
- Look both ways and uphill before crossing trails or merging
- Dress in layers consider a helmet
- Have equipment professionally fitted/adjusted
