


#### **Bears and Wildlife**

As temperatures start warming up, bears in Alaska will begin waking from hibernation and other wildlife becomes more active. This typically starts the beginning of April, but could happen sooner, depending on warming temperatures.

#### Tips for Encountering Wild Alaska!

- Do not feed wildlife
  - Proper use of receptacles helps mitigate risk
  - Intentionally or negligently feeding wildlife will get you ticketed/them euthanized
- Do not approach wildlife
  - Human contact can cause the animal to feel threatened & attack
  - Approaching animals can cause them to lose their natural fear of humans



\* Especially stay away from a mother moose and young. Even if the mother is not in the immediate area, she will come back!
