

- Avoid fatigue and stick to a schedule

Watch for Wildlife

- Bears are now active
- Give plenty of space and make yourself known
- Do not feed the wildlife
- Check trailhead for animal activity warnings

Practice Trail Safety

- Use the buddy system and practice Risk Management
- Bring more supplies than needed

Wildfire Preparedness and Prevention

- Keep lawn short and properly watered
- Keep gutters clean and store combustible material at least 30 feet away
- Know your evacuation routes and be prepared to evacuate

































Grilling Safety



- 10,600 home fires started by grills on average
 - Nearly 20K burn injuries a year from grills
 - Keep kids and pets away
- Grills should be placed in an open area
 - Not within 10 feet of any combustible structure
 - Storage must not be closer that 5 feet from doorways or windows





- Never leave unattended
 - Check gas tank hose for leaks before first use
 - Keep the grill clean by removing grease buildup to prevent fires
- Propane and charcoal grills should only be used outdoors






