

Road Conditions







- Roads are clear and dry
- Normal vehicle operating procedures and posted speed limits
- Motorcycles may operate on JBER



- Roads slippery due to snow, ice, debris, or reduced visibility
- Drivers will exercise caution
- Motorcycles may <u>not</u> operate on JBER.



- Roads hazardous due to snow, ice, debris, or reduced visibility
- Reduce speeds by 10 mph below posted speed limit for 25 mph & higher
- Reduce speeds by 5 mph below posted speed limit for 20 mph & lower
- Motorcycles may not operate on JBER



- Roads extremely hazardous due to ice, snow, debris, or reduced visibility
- Vehicle dispatching is prohibited unless directed by command authority
- Only operate mission essential and emergency response vehicles
- Same speed limits as condition Red (no motorcycles)



Winterization



PRIOR TO WINTER

- Remove trampolines and basketball hoops from yards and driveways (no later than 15 Oct)
- Remove personal items from decks and the exterior of the home
- Check/replace batteries in digital thermostats
- Remove hoses from outdoor faucets and place a hose bibb cover over the faucet (hose bibb covers available at Self Help for free)
- Store grass seed and pet food in sealed containers
- Clean up pet waste from yards

DURING WINTER MONTHS

- Do not open windows after first freeze
- Check filters monthly, change no less than every 90 days (filters are available at Self Help for free)
- Shovel snow into lawns, not the street
- Run cold water in lower level sinks at pencil width, while home
- Fill out a Notice of Absence when leaving home for long period. Have a responsible party check your home daily. Visit https://www.auroramilitaryhousing.com/residents/notice-of-absence/



























Snow Removal Plan



SNOW EVENTS

- 2" or more of accumulation
- 2 days to recover from a snow event
 - Snow event during recovery resets the clock
- Deployed Spouse homes completed in first
 24 hours after snow event
- Snow removal conducted between 0800 & 2200 (quiet hours observed)
- Communication to residents via blog, email list, & Facebook (Move vehicles from road)

Managing Winter Leaks



PREVENTATIVE ROOF SNOW REMOVAL

- Dedicated contractor will monitor roof conditions
- Homes with excessive accumulation or ice damming will be proactively scheduled for roof snow removal and hauling
 - Aurora will provide notice to residents

REPORTING LEAKS

- Contact Aurora emergency maintenance at 907.753.1091
- Aurora will dispatch emergency technician, who may:
 - Determine source of leak and stop, if able (i.e.: busted pipe)
 - Cut hole in ceiling/wall to enable air flow and prevent mold
 - Dispatch water extraction contractor
 - Schedule follow up work

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

- Remove personal items from the deck at the beginning of the season to prevent damage
- Do not store valuable or personal items in the basement
- Contact maintenance at the first sign of a leak or if heat goes out
- Keep windows closed when temperatures are below freezing
