

EFMP Respite Child Care Program (USAF & USSF)

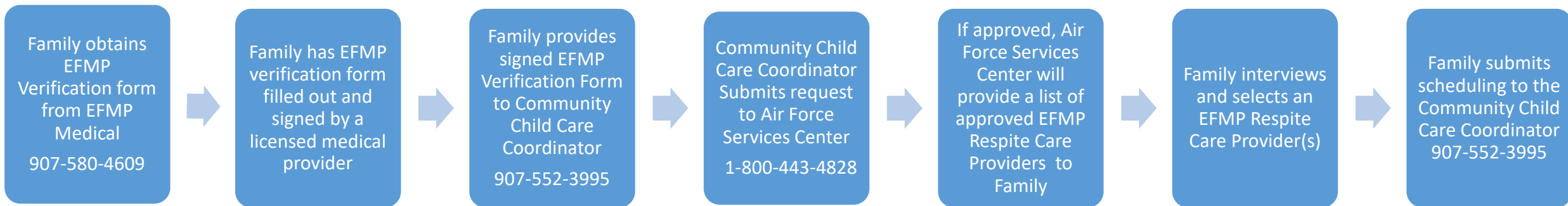
WHAT IS “RESPITE CARE”? This program provides Air Force (USAF) and Space Force (USSF) EFMP* families short-term, specialized childcare to help reduce the stresses associated with caring for an EFM child

- Care provided for the EFM up to 19 years of age and typical developing sibling up to 13 years of age
- Care is not for members and/or their spouses to go to work or attend school

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR RESPITE CARE?

- Sponsor must be Active Duty USAF or USSF, or Air Force Reserve/Air National Guard Member in an Active Duty status (Title 10 or Title 32 Orders)
- Sponsor must be Q-coded
 - Sponsor must be assigned to the installation
- EFM child must reside with the sponsor
- Verification of at least one EFM child has been classified as “Moderate” or “Severe”
