



Bowling Volunteer Descriptions (General “day of” Volunteers)

Lane Monitor – Assists teams on the lanes. Bowling experience helpful but not required. Reports to Pit Monitor who will address any bowling equipment/sport related questions.

Pit Monitor – Bowling experience required. Assists Bowling Commissioner, Competition Manager and Eagle River Bowl Staff with managing the event. Oversees 10 or more lanes.

Awards – Works under Awards Leader. Prepares awards for presentation. Assists with presentations.

Volunteer Check In/Information Services – Works under Volunteer Leader. Registers “day of” volunteers, gives them their t-shirt, and directs the volunteer to the appropriate leader and assigned position. Communicates with Competition and other leaders to ensure open positions are filled in.

Operations - works under Special Olympics Alaska staff and Operations Leader. Assists with loading/unloading trucks, setting up/taking down venues, maintaining venue during competition.
