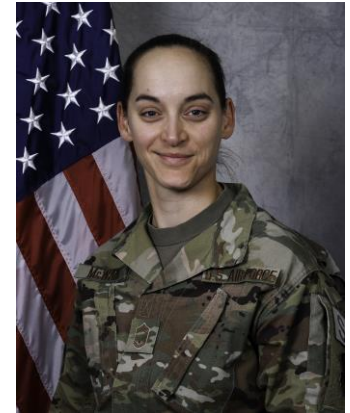

Chief Jessica L. McWain is the Security Forces Manager for the 386th Expeditionary Security Forces Squadron, Ali Al Salem Air Base, Kuwait. In this capacity, she leads 219 Total Force Security Forces members and 14 contractors in the security of the installation, base security zone and 4,200 base personnel. Additionally, she advises the commander to ensure personnel are ready, trained and equipped for full-spectrum force protection operations in support of Operations FREEDOM'S SENTINEL and DELIBERATE RESOLVE.

Chief McWain hails from New Kensington, Pennsylvania and entered the Air Force in August 2000 as a Security Forces member. She held a multitude of positions throughout her career across the tactical and managerial level. She has deployed in support of peacekeeping, contingency, and combat operations in the Balkans, Haiti and Southwest Asia, earning the Combat Action Medal during her tour in support of Operation IRAQI FREEDOM. Prior to her current position, Chief McWain was the Operations and Training Superintendent, 66th Security Forces Squadron, Hanscom Air Force Base, Massachusetts.
